

GUATEMALA 2011



The Botran Family, which has been making sugarcane spirit since 1939, is the source of the world-renowned Guatemalan rums. Produced from virgin sugar cane honey and distilled in column stills, Botran rums age 2300 meters in altitude at the center of the country. They are aged in four different types of casks according to a precise process inspired by the solera method, offering remarkable complexity to the rums. This rum matured in ex-Bourbon and ex-Oloroso casks and is limited to 1.371 bottles.

Tasting Notes:

Open on the nose with woody notes. A smooth and delicate attack on the palate offering vanilla, honey and sweet spices aromas in the mid-palate. A short and clean finish.
